### **Processed data, purpose and legal basis**

Data shall be collected and recorded in accordance with the principles and requirements set out in Article 5c 1 of GDPR. The processing of personal data shall take place by means of information technology for any promotional purpose. Technical data relating to the user's session shall be anonymous and shall be used only for statistical purposes and to allow the user full access to the use of the site.

### **User's rights**

## Cookie Policy

Cookies are text files containing minimum information sent to browser and stored on the computer, telephone or other user device, whenever a website is visited. To each link, the cookies refer the information to the reference site.

In the follow-up to this document, we will refer to cookies and all similar technologies by simply using the term "cookie".

The cookie information can only be read by the web server and may contain different data such as, for example, the name of the server from which it originates, a digital identifier, etc. Cookies shall not store any personal information, such as the name, surname or e-mail address.

There are different types of cookies, but essentially the main purpose of a cookie is to make the site work more effectively and to enable specific functionalities.

Cookies may be permanent (persistent cookies) if they remain on the computer until the user removes them, or temporary (sessional cookies) if they are deactivated when the browser used for web navigation is closed.

Cookies may also be first-part cookies if placed on the visited site, or third party cookies, if placed on a site other than the one visited.

### **How we use cookies.**

We use cookies to improve the functionality of our website, allow the user to move easily across the pages, remember its preferences and to ensure that the user has always optimum navigational experience.

### **Cookies used and their purpose.**

The types of cookies that can be used in the Site with a description of the purpose related to the use are given below.

### **Technical Cookies.**

We use cookies of this kind because they are necessary for the proper functioning of certain areas of the site or for quicker and faster navigation and use.

They can be used, for example, to visualise the contents on your device recognising the language and market in the country from which you chose to connect you; if you are a registered user, they will allow you to recognise you and access the services offered in dedicated areas.

The cookies in this category include both persistent cookies and session cookies. In the absence of such cookies, the site or some parts of it may not function properly.

Therefore, they are always used, irrespective of user preferences.

The holder, pursuant to Article 122 of the Privacy Code and the Guarantor's Provement of 8 May 2014, is not obliged to request the user's consent for technical cookies, as these are strictly necessary for the provision of the service.

## **Third party statistical Cookies.**

They are cookies that are used directly from our website to collect information, in aggregated and anonymous form, on the number of users and on how they visit the site. For example, cookies of this kind are used to collect information on the use of the website by visitors, the key words used to reach the site, the origins of the traffic from which visitors come.

Our website uses pooled navigation data analysis tools, i.e. Google Analytics system made available to Google Inc, which allows it to improve its functionality. Google Analytics uses a set of cookies to collect information and generate statistics for the use of the website without personal identification of individual visitors.

Google uses the information generated by the cookie to track and examine the user's use of website, to compile reports on the activities of our website.

These cookies are completely anonymous and are only used to help our company improve the functioning of our website and to understand the interests of users.

The user can selectively disable the action of Google Analytics by installing on his browser the opt-out component provided by Google. To disable Google Analytics's action, return to the plugin link.

## **Other cookies of third parties.**

Third Parties cookies are related to services provided by third parties, e.g. "I like" and "Share" buttons. These services are provided by third parties in exchange for the recognition that our website has been visited by the user.

This site also incorporates plugins and/or buttons for social networks in order to allow content to be easily shared on your favorite social networks Facebook, Google Plus, Twitter or YouTube. These are parts of the visited page directly generated by those sites and integrated on the page of the host site.

We do not control the cookies used by these services, so we call on the user to access the website of these third parties for the relevant information.
